Here are the highlights of what we'll be most focused on in 2013

- **Safe Healthy Community Map** – We want to turn those many safe routes based on crowd-sourced wisdom from multiple neighborhoods into a citywide safe healthy community map people can access on line.
- **Support** - Support new Greenways groups, with a particular focus on diverse communities.
- **Meetups** - Continue educating our members with a focus on Green Storm Water Infrastructure, Safe Routes to School, and Greenways and Public Health, among other topics
- **Grow** a working Board and grow the capacity of existing groups - this includes building a really good membership database.
